The National Housing Strategy

The National Housing Strategy (NHS) introduced on November 22, 2017 promised rights-based legislation to implement the government's commitment to the progressive implementation of the right to housing, as guaranteed in the *International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights*. In May 2019 the right to housing became law in Canada when the National Housing Strategy was finally passed. The NHS was allocated \$55 billion over 10 years and is expected to help 530 thousand families out of housing need, to modernize 300 thousand homes and build another 125 thousand homes (Young, 2019). Review the original policy document, Canada's National Housing Strategy: A Place to Call Home (2017). The Government of Canada's 2021 budget adds an additional \$2.5 billion in new funding as well as releasing an additional \$1.3 billion of funds allocated to future years.


